



THE VAR, 1ST FRENCH HOLIDAY DESTINATION AFTER PARIS

Var key tourism figures:

- > 8.25 million stays
- > 1.07 international stays
- > 63.6 million overnight stays
- > 45% overnight stays in commercial accommodation
- > Average holiday duration 8 days

With over 400 km of coastline along the Mediterranean Sea, the Var is a terrain of contrasts, where islands, mountains, lakes, forests, and 400,000 hectares of oak and pine woodlands intermingle.

THE SEA SIDE

A nautical destination due to its exceptionally beautiful landscapes and seabeds.

The coastline's most beautiful sites:

5 inhabited islands (Embiez, Bendor, Porquerolles, Port-Cros, and the Levant), beaches, and authentic rocky inlets known as calanques, the Toulon Harbour, the Giens Peninsula, and the red rocks of the Estérel Mountains.

Exceptional-quality diving: seafloor diversity, preservation of flora and fauna, world-renowned diving spots, crystal clear water and water/air temperatures that enable year-round diving.



From the surface, you can explore the richness of the underwater environment, the various ecosystems, and the Mediterranean Seawhile swimming with fins, snorkelling, discovering underwater trails...







THE BEACHES

The Var has 230 beaches and coves on the shores of the "big blue".

But which beach should you choose? Small isolated coves or large family beaches, pebbles or white sand, grey sand or red pebbles...

Beaches with access for people with disabilities, water activities nearby, showers, shady beaches, beaches sheltered from the Mistral, nude beaches, unspoiled beaches... the Var has beaches for everyone.







HARBORS AND FISHING PORTS

Over 50 harbours to accommodate you!

From small authentic fishing ports to large marinas accommodating sailboats and yachts, anything is possible. Marinas can be found in every coastal town. Most of them are lively places with a large number of shops, restaurants and bars, as well as sea-related events (jousts, feasts of Saint Peter, blessing fishing boats...).





In April 2008, the Var founded a cruise club: "Le Var Provence Cruise Club". Resulting from a partnership between the Chamber of Commerce and Industry and the Var Departmental Council, this organization unites public and private tourism stakeholders who are involved in the cruise industry, including the Var's 12 harbours that welcome cruise passengers. The agenda for the Toulon harbours (Toulon and the Seyne-sur-Mer) consisted of 135 stopovers by ships carrying up to 3,600 passengers.

In total, the Var harbours hosted **some 400,000 passengers over the course of 300 stopovers** in 2016.
